The Valencia Oranges have been very good, Prices are in the mid to high range and showing good color and flavor. Imported Navels and Tangerines inconsistent container arrivals at this time.

APPLES & PEARS

The Westside Melon deal is in full swing. Cantaloupes, Honeydews, Galia, Persians, Sharlynns and Kiss Melons are all in.

California **Raspberries** and **Blackberries** are stable after the Spring to Summer variety shift.

Blueberries are from California, Mexico, Baja and even Florida. This market has been up and down mostly due to Transportation issues.
