The Valencia crop is getting tired and small sized fruit is getting scarce. Some quality issues are arising due to heat and water issues.

The **Navel** crop is set to start in early November. Offshore Blood Oranges and Cara Cara's are finished.

The Lemon market remains on fire as California Lemons supplies dwindle for much the same reason as oranges. Mexican Lemons are set to start in the coming weeks.

APPLES & PEARS

New crop Honey Crisp, Fuji's and Gala's and Pink Ladies are trickling in. Look for more variety of stock on hand week after next!
The D'Anjou pear is back.

Small sized Bosc pear are a great school size!

BERRIES

All Berries are a bit stressed due to past heat waves. Typically bruising and a really short shelf life.



We are bringing in some Chilean Murcot Tangerines, sizing is on the large side as we wait for our Domestic crop to start.

The local melon deal is rapidly closing as cooler nights prevail. **Cantaloupe, Honeydews, Watermelons** have been excellent all season. **Look for Mexican fruit in the coming weeks.**

Quality can certainly vary from region to region as California winds down. The Baja Los Pino's have been very steady but starting to creep up. **Cherry Toms and grape Toms** have stayed a bit high.

Local Heirlooms and Mixed Cherry Tomatoes are still and look very good.

We are looking at higher pricing as Mexican fruit gives way to Brazil as the new supply chain.

The Southern trek is set to begin by mid November as grower head south to our Fall and Winter home.

Anything from China, Taiwan and all ports in between are short on people and trucks.

Imported exotic Mushrooms have seen a 50 to 100% price rise.

Local domestic White Mushrooms, Crimini Mushrooms and Shitake's have had supply issues.

Yellow Onions, Red Onions and Potato prices are rising as storage counts dwindle.

New crop Washington product is set to start in the coming weeks as grower/shippers line up labor and trucking.
